



Ulmus LUTECE® 'Nanguen'

A beautiful elm resistant to Dutch elm disease, for hedges and other plantations

Selected by INRAE for its resistance to graphiosis (a disease that has been decimating elms since 1970), this variety of elm is a handsome, medium-sized tree that grows quickly, evenly and uniformly. It can be left to grow freely, or trained as a stem, pollard or vining tree.

Its dense, dark green foliage takes on beautiful golden yellow colours in autumn. In March, its discreet flowering is followed by bunches of yellow-green winged fruit. Ideal for a hedge, it also looks great as an isolated specimen or in a stem row.
