

## Carpinus betulus ROCKHAMPTON RED 'Lochglow'

## A flamboyant autumn

Early in autumn the leaves colour in different shades of bright red and orange. These tints last several weeks, until mid-November. Then the leaves turn brown. They are marcescent.

Growth is rapid. It is oval-shaped but since the variety tolerates pruning very well, it can be grown in a trimmed hedge.

ROCKHAMPTON RED 'Lochglow' is noticeable from far in the autumn and adds a bright note, be it in rows or in hedges.
