ULTRA BLUE 'TUISOL'

A novel climber with multiple, intensely blue bell-like flowers

Very beautiful twining plant flowering freely from June to September. ULTRA BLUE produces flowers of a luminous blue, deeper than the typical variety, its habit is well-branched. The whole forms a well-developed climbing shrub from which emerge numerous tiny bells of blue.

In open ground it should be limited to very mild, coastal climates. Elsewhere in pots, over-winter protected from the cold.


