Imperial honeysuckle : an avalanche of beautiful red, fragrant flowers.

All fragrant, the climbing honeysuckles of the CAPRILIA® range are stemming from INRA research. They have been selected in collaboration with SAPHINOV nurserymen. From mid June to July this flower bearing variety is particularly remarkable due to its big florets over the entire height of the plant. The fragrant flowers are carmine red in the bud stage, turning cream, then yellow. Big red berries appear in September. The dark green foliage is resistant. To be trained.
