Pittosporum tenuifolium 'Golf Ball'

Recommended for its low, naturally ball shaped growth

Originally from New Zealand, 'Golf Ball' has a very round shape, not exceeding 1 m. Being of rapid growth, it is characterized by its dense branches from the base upwards. Its evergreen foliage is light green. 'Golf Ball' resists rather well to drought, and to temperatures of -5 to -10° C. It is excellent for the sea side because it accepts mist and wind. Recommended for small areas and low hedges, it is also suitable for pots and as topiary, like box.
