## The pleasure to plant a Corydalis!

After taking its winter break, BLUE LINE® produces a vigourous attractive mat of tender green, lobed foliage. Flowering begins in April - May and under good conditions, continues abundantly until September - October, some clusters of flowers last up to the first frosts. The flowers grow in regularly spaced tiers of thick clusters, carried by numerous reddy brown upright stems. They are deep metallic blue with a white throat and develop a sweet honey-like scent.

In containers or in the garden. Half-shade location.
