



# Daphne odora 'Sweet Amethyst'

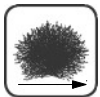
***An amethyst bloom with a powerful jasmine scent.***

The originality of this new variety is the violet-lilac of its flowers that start blooming in March. The abundant flowers release a powerful jasmine scent detectable from metres away. Its other features are typical of the perfumed Daphne: attractive clusters of star-shaped, tubular flowers, persistent, brilliant green foliage and tough, lanceolate leaves. It forms a small, shrubby bush.
