

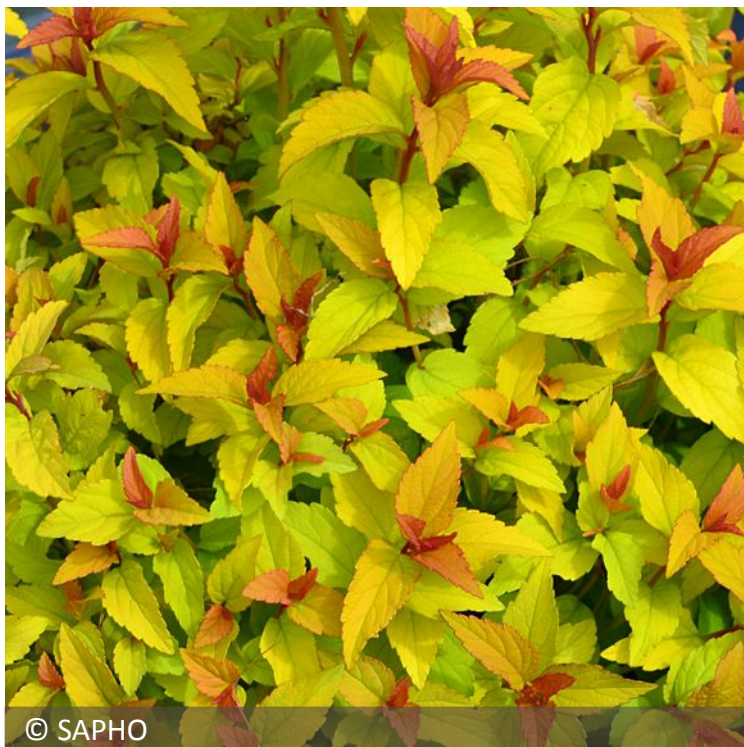


Spiraea japonica

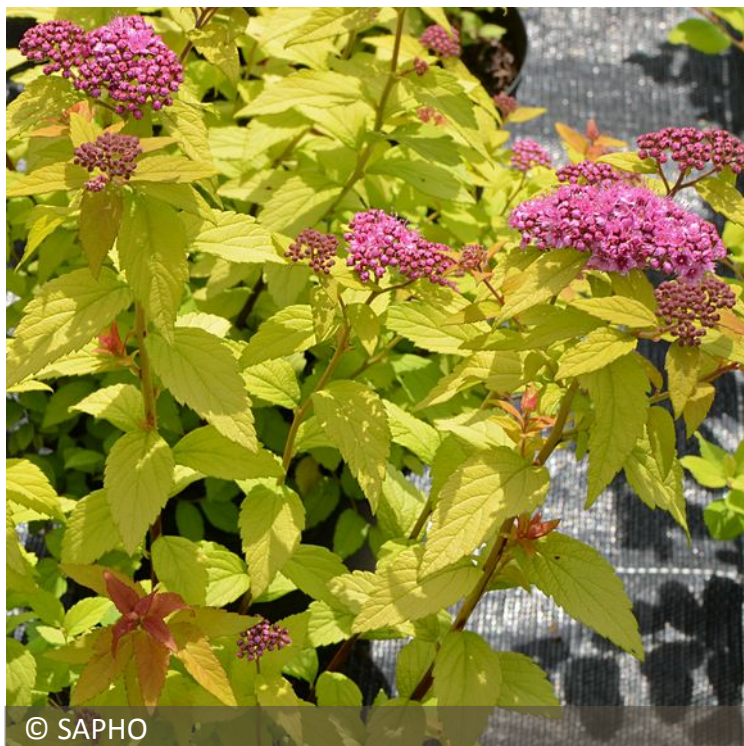
MERLO® Gold 'DAVCOP04'

In spring, the foliage of Merlo® Gold is remarkably intense, combining young firey-red shoots and small lemon-yellow leaves. In summer the foliage remains yellow. The habit is naturally round and regular. In June Merlo® Gold is covered with a multitude of small dark red flowers. Resistant to powdery mildew, this new spirea will mix wonderfully in beds with other shrubs or colourfully-leaved perennials.

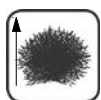

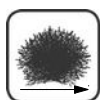
