

Loropetalum chinense 'Ruby Runner'

A beautiful ruby-red colour 'running' all vear round!

The name of 'Ruby Runner' comes from its handsome, evergreen foliage of ruby and purple red and its creeping or weeping form. From the end of February to April an abundance of dark pink flowers appear, and, if it is not pruned, Ruby Runner will flower again in summer. Small size and hanging habit create a beautiful impression in low beds, as ground cover or hanging. It favours fertile, welldrained soils and needs little attention.
