



SAMBUCUS WELSH GOLD 'WALFINB'

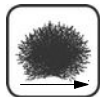
Garden elegance with this unusual elderberry

Here is an unusual and very ornamental elderberry. Its fine, lacinated leaves develop from golden to a shiny green-yellow. Its elegant, layered habit give it the look of a Japanese maple. Flowering is early, forming clusters of white flowers at the end of spring, followed by magnificent attractif red berries in summer. Sambucus Welsh Gold is slow-growing and easy to cultivate and will be at home in small and large gardens.

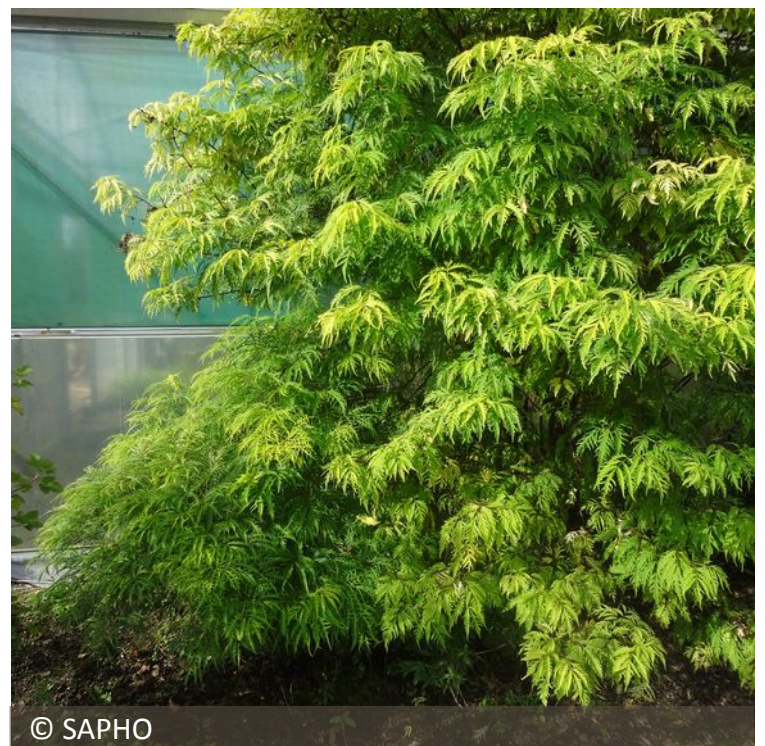
