Erica nana **Limoncello**® 'ni1co'

A highly unusual heather for mild climates

In spring, Erica nana Limoncello[®] blooms with a beautiful profusion of bright lemon yellow flowers, contrasting against the dark green foliage. The flowers are large, tubular and ca. 2 cm long. Ideal in containers, this is a dwarf, slow-growing shrub with an upright habit.

Limoncello[®] is best suited to mild climates or coastal areas. Elsewhere, it can be grown in containers with well-drained soil, and brought inside for the winter.


