

Hydrangea paniculata **DIAMANTINO** ® 'REN101'

A little jewel.

This selection is particularly interesting for its density and abundance of flowers.

The very bushy panicles of the sterile flowers are carried by straight stems. The 20 cm long flower heads have a round shape. Yellow-green at first, the panicles become white and then pink at maturity.

The abundant flowering starts quite early in mid-July, lasting up to the end of August - September.

DIAMANTINO® has an upright shape, slightly flared. It goes well in a shrub border or in a pot.


