This bright variety of Perovskia is dense and upright and maintains its beautiful shape.

Its aromatic foliage is silvery grey-white, the robust stems have metallic highlights.

Slightly scented lavender blue flowers come out first in June-July. Pruning in early August allows a second, denser flowering.

SILVER BLUE is resistant to drought, prefers a sunny spot, but tolerates half shade.
