

Spiraea japonica MERLO[®] Green 'DAVROU01'

Young bright purple foliage, followed by intense carmine pink flowers

The shoots, at first bright purple red, then darker make a contrast with the overall green foliage. The subtly veined leaf blades stay purple for a while before changing to dark green. The plant is not very sensitive to powdery mildew. In June it is covered in carmine pink flowers of up to 8 cm. Taking off the first wilted corymbs favours renewed flowering.

MERLO[®] Green has a regular round growth of moderate dimensions. It can be grown in pots.
