



## Actinidia deliciosa 'HERMA'

### A self-fertile kiwi plant with very large fruits !

Self-fertile flowers: one plant is enough to get fruits! Once it's settled (after 3 years), the plant provides large fruits, more and more over the years. Fruits as big or bigger than 'Hayward', (the reference but not self-fertile). Sparsely hairy fruits with a green, sweet, and juicy flesh.

Vigorous and voluble vines with large round leaves, to fence along an arbour, a wall, in full sun but sheltered from wind. Prune in Winter.

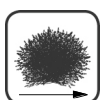
