



Hydrangea macrophylla DOLCE[®] Farfalle 'DOLFARF'

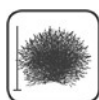
A profusion of pink balls in summer.

DOLCE[®] is an Hydrangea macrophylla range, suitable for the garden: density, abundance and quality of the flowering. In shrub beds, the DOLCE[®] varieties blend in harmoniously. They can also be grown in pots to embellish terraces and balconies.

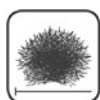
Although these shrubs prefer humus rich soil, they adapt to every type of substrate, as long as it is fresh.

Farfalle is spectacular from the end of June with its ball-shaped inflorescences of florets with deep pink scalloped petals.
