This Cornus produces superb, abundant white blossoms from late May to early June. The fruit, of an original color, is yellow at first and turns pumpkinorange when ripe. Its deciduous foliage is green, turning orange in autumn. This plant is easy to grow, vigorous and has a flared habit when young. A great shrub that deserves a special place in the garden.
