

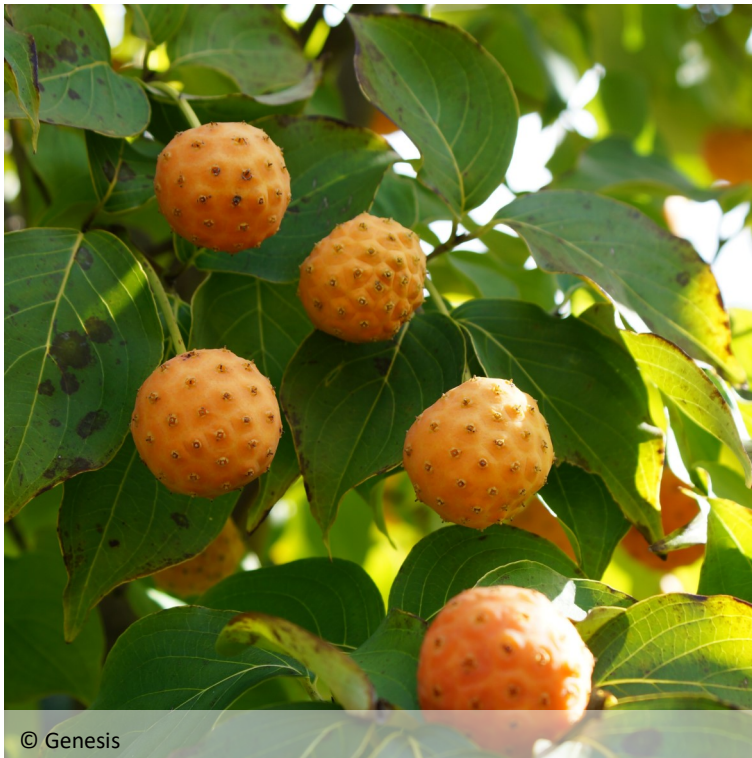


Cornus kousa var chinensis

This Cornus produces superb, abundant white blossoms from late May to early June. The fruit, of an original color, is yellow at first and turns pumpkin-orange when ripe. Its deciduous foliage is green, turning orange in autumn. This plant is easy to grow, vigorous and has a flared habit when young. A great shrub that deserves a special place in the garden.

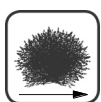
